



















NATURE DAY CAMP!

WHO: 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders

WHEN: Session A - Tues & Wed April 16 & 17, 2019

<u>Session B</u> - Thurs & Fri April 18 & 19, 2019

WHERE: YMCA Camp of Maine, East Winthrop





Schedule: Two 2-day sessions for you to choose from! Session A will be Tuesday & Wednesday, April 16 & 17, 2019 & Session B will be Thursday & Friday, April 18 & 19, 2019. Camp runs daily from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. Each camp day will consist of both fun indoor <u>and</u> outdoor activities - with the goal of being outdoors as much as possible - dependent on weather conditions and camper's energy levels! Activities are based on appreciation and understanding of nature and the great outdoors.

Please be sure to indicate your preferred session choice and time on the form below!

Location: Camp will be held at the YMCA Camp of Maine on Cobbossee Lake in East Winthrop, ME. Directions will be provided upon camp registration. Parents will be responsible for providing transportation to and from camp.



What to Bring: Campers need to come prepared for time outdoors in spring conditions, which means being prepared for just about anything! This includes, but is not limited to: rainproof coat, rain pants to put on over clothes if necessary, warm layers, rubber boots if possible for mud & water, warm weather clothing depending on weather, warm socks, hiking shoes or boots and back-ups of any of the above if possible! Campers will also need to bring a healthy morning snack and lunch, as well as a refillable water bottle. (An afternoon snack will be provided!)

Registration: The cost of the camp is \$90 (9-3) or \$105 (8:30-4:30) per camper for each 2-day session. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and **space is limited**. A signed registration form and payment must be received before the beginning of camp in order for your child to participate. Please make checks payable to FOCW.
