Responsibilities:

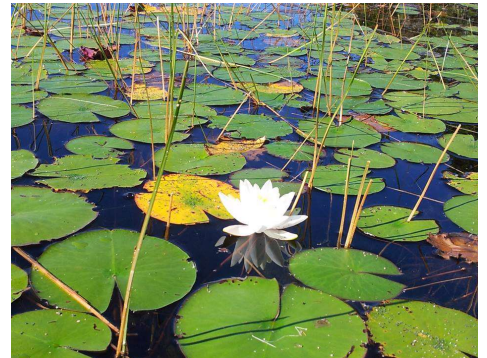
- Survey lakes in the Cobbossee Watershed for invasive aquatic plants

- Track & report data
- Develop and distribute educational materials

- Interest in Botany, Biology, Environmental Science, Ecology, Science Education, or other closely related field
- Comfortable interacting with the public
- Responsibility and maturity
- Clear communicator (verbal and written)
- Detailed record keeping
- Mapping (GIS) and GPS experience
- A PASSION for protecting Maine's lakes!

Preferred Qualifications:

- Plant identification or an interest & ability to learn quickly.
- SCUBA certifications and experience diving and snorkeling.
- Comfortable operating motorized & non-motorized watercraft.
