
VARIABLE-LEAF WATER MILFOIL

- ~Variable-leaf milfoil is an invasive aquatic plant which disrupts natural ecosystems once established. Variable-leaf milfoil grows quickly, spreads easily, and forms large mats of plants.
- ~ This invasive was confirmed in Pleasant Pond and Cobbossee Stream in 2001, although it had likely been in existence for some time prior to its
