Schedule: This year's camp once again offers (2) 2-day sessions for you to choose from! Session A will be Monday & Tuesday, Feb. 20 & 21, 2023 and Session B will be Wednesday & Thursday, Feb 22 & 23, 2023 with Friday (2/24) as an alternative in case of inclement weather during the week. Camp runs daily from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. Each camp day will consist of both fun indoor and outdoor activities - with the goal of being outdoors as much as possible - dependent on weather conditions and camper's energy levels! Themes for this year's camp will include exploring the outdoors and continuing to foster understanding and appreciation.
Please be sure to indicate your preferred session choice on the form below!



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Location: Camp will be held in the Memorial Chapel at Camp Mechuwana in Winthrop. Parents will be responsible for providing transportation to and from camp.

What to Bring: Campers need to come prepared for time outdoors in winter conditions. This includes, but is not limited to: warm winter coat, snow pants or baggy rain pants to put over clothes, long underwear, warm pants and sweater or fleece, winter boots, two pairs of thick socks, mittens or gloves, hat, shoes for indoors and back-ups of any of the above if possible as campers tend to get wet! Campers will also need to bring a healthy morning snack and lunch, as well as a refillable water bottle. (Afternoon warm-up cocoa with light snack will be provided!)

Registration: The cost of the camp is \$100 per each 2-day session. <u>Registration is on a first-come, first-served</u> basis, and **space is limited**. A signed registration form and payment must be received before the beginning of camp in order for your child to participate.
